Speaker Bio

Steve Fridinger, DC is a chiropractic radiologist at Consulting Radiologists, Ltd (CRL) in the Minneapolis, MN. Dr. Fridinger joined CRL in 2004 from Northwestern Health Sciences University (NWHHSU) where he completed his degree of Doctor of Chiropractic in 1998. He then continued at NWHHSU to complete his Diplomate in Chiropractic Radiology in 2001 through the American Chiropractic Board of Radiology. He has taught many ACRRT certification courses recertification courses for the WCA over the past 10 years. He strives to teach students pertinent information in an interactive and entertaining format.

Course Descriptions

Receive your continuing education to renew your CRT Certificate in just one weekend. You may attend one session of the CRT Radiology series as a refresher (no exam needed if you already have the CRT Certificate) or get your education from the two other programs offered.

The **Improving the X-Ray Skills of a CRT** class will provide an overview of radiology, in-depth review of radiation protection as well as focus on positioning for the spine and upper and lower extremities. Case studies and practical applications will also be discussed.

The **Anatomy of a Successful CRT** program is designed to review basic x-ray physics for the acquisition of high quality films, to introduce the differences in digital vs. conventional x-ray, and to review human anatomy and its application in positioning and x-ray examination. This class will be lecture-style, but will also include interactive components and "hands-on" demonstrations during the anatomy and positioning segments.

Since receiving her degree in 1992 she has participated on many committees for chiropractic related issues and has taught a variety of educational courses, presentations, and workshops concerning chiropractic related topics. Course Description: CRT Radiology

- basic principles of X-ray
- introductory anatomy
- radiation protection
- film handling & processing
- radiography in chiropractic practice
- X-ray exposure factors
- Patient positioning
